About the Conference

Today's world is considered to be an era of technology. The internet has been lauded as the greatest invention since the wheel and is undeniably an integral part of modern life. Like other advanced technology including the printing press and the telephone it has had dramatic effects on society. This technology has changed the way individuals interact, shop, search for jobs, and get directions, how they work, and how they spend their leisure time. In its essence the internet is a facilitator of global communication and it has impacted the speed, quantity and accessibility for knowledge transfer. As our culture becomes increasingly dependent on such technologies, some individuals develop problematic behavior related to too much time spent on the internet. Excessive use of the internet has been linked to significant impairment in critical areas of functioning including social, academic, career and physical health. Excessive forms of internet usage has shown that uncontrolled or compulsive use of the internet negatively affects psychological well-being. 'Internet Addiction' has been recognized as a threat to mental health and been included in the latest Diagnostic Statistical Manual.

The Department of Counseling Psychology, University of Madras, has organized the present National Conference to explore and experience the latest development in dealing with Internet Addiction.

About the Department:

The Department of Counselling Psychology, University of Madras was started in the year 2015. The Department Offers PG, MPhil and Research (Ph.D) programs in Counselling Psychology. The Department also offers PG Diploma program in Counselling and Psychotherapy, Diploma in Learning Disability and Diploma in Autism Spectrum Disorder. Currently 150 students have registered under various programs in this Department. The courses are designed considering diversity in rapidly changing and globalized society, and the need for counselors in every field.
